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Rules and Regulations

1. MHSAA rules of eligibility and USBC rules will guide this tournament.
2. This tournament will use a STANDARD HOUSE SHOT for competition.
3. This event is open to all current high school bowlers who will participate in High school competition for the 2011 – 2012 bowling season. Varsity and JV bowlers are welcome. There will be a Varsity Division and a Junior Varsity Division for boys and girls.
4. All bowlers shall bowl scratch (no handicap).
5. Only registered bowlers may bowl.
6. ENTRY FEE: A fee of \$20.00 per bowler must accompany the entry. No refunds will be issued. Checks returned for insufficient funds will be assessed a \$25.00 fee.
7. Errors in scoring must be reported to the Tournament Director immediately. Changes in scoring can only be made by the tournament management.
8. Bowlers shall report 1 hour before squad time. Coaches are responsible for checking in bowlers with the tournament committee.
9. Bowlers shall bring their own equipment, especially shoes if possible. All equipment used in the tournament must meet USBC specifications. Illegal equipment will constitute a forfeit and scores for the event shall be disallowed.
10. Bowling Attire: All bowlers shall be dressed team uniforms. School shirts must reflect the name of the school and/or the school logo or mascot.
11. Only registered bowlers will be allowed in the immediate bowling area.
12. Bowlers are required to have positive identification (school ID) on them at all times. Bowlers will be required to show their identification when checking in. Bowlers checking in without identification will not be allowed to bowl.
13. Tardy bowlers: Bowling shall begin in accordance with a previously arranged schedule, unless the tournament manager authorizes a delay. Any player arriving late shall begin play (no warm-up) with the score counting beginning with the frame and game in progress. All frames missed will be assessed zero points.
14. No tobacco products, drinking of alcoholic beverages or unsportsmanlike conduct will be permitted while participating in the event. Outside food or drinks SHALL NOT be brought into the center. This rule shall apply to all spectators as well. Bowlers will not be permitted the use of amusement games or pool tables during his/her competition.
15. Any disputes during the tournament or exceptions to the above rules and regulations will be resolved at the discretion of the tournament manager and/or the tournament committee.
16. All scores as recorded and verified on score sheets are FINAL. Corrections will only be made on computer errors.

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Competition Format

1. There will be two divisions for boys and two divisions for girls.
2. This event will be a four game format with total pin fall used to qualify for match play.
3. Lane assignments will be pre-assigned by the tournament committee prior to check-in.
4. At 8:15am, a 15 minute practice session will begin.
5. Bowlers will bowl 4 games across 8 lanes. After each game, even number lane assignments will move one pair to the right. Odd number lane assignments will move one pair to the left. Even or odd starting lane assignments and bowling order shall be maintained when moving. One lane courtesy shall be observed during competition.
6. There will be an approximate 30 minute meal break after the qualifier. During this time, the tournament committee will cut the field based on the number of entries per division. The tournament committee will use a 1 in 4 cut ratio as a guideline.
7. After the meal break, a 5 minute practice session will begin for final competition. In the event of a tie for the last qualifying position, there will be a 9th and 10th frame roll off between all bowlers involved. This will repeat as necessary until the tie is broken and will occur before the start of the practice session.
8. Competition will be seeded utilizing the NCAA match-up format. Tie-breakers will be used in seeding where needed. There will be a maximum of four rounds in the finals. In the event there the cut ratio allows more than 16 qualifiers in a division, the first round will consist of a single game roll off and the top 8 scores will advance to the second round for head to head competition being seeded based upon the morning qualifying scores.
9. Bowlers will bowl head-to-head with a single game determining the winner. Winners move on until the field has been reduced to the final four. In the event of a tie in any match, there will be a 9th/10th frame roll off.
10. Winners of the final four matches will roll-off to decide first and second place.
11. A consolation match will be run to decide third and fourth place.
12. Awards will be presented to the top four bowlers in each division at the end of competition.
